rm *file1 file2 ...* **Remove a number of files**
rm -r *directory* **Remove a directory include the sub-directory**
- **rmdir *directory*** **Remove a directory**

CD	cd	Change directory
CHKDSK	du	Disk usage
CLS	clear	Clear the current screen
COPY	cp	Copying files
DEL	rm	Removing files or directories
DIR	ls	File listing of directories
MD	mkdir	Create a directory
MORE	more	Type out a file with paging
PRINT	lpr	Print out a file
RD	rmdir	Remove a directory
RENAME	mv	Moving files around
TYPE	cat	Type out files

Who, When, Why, What and Where?

- **man cp** Display on-line manual for the “cp” command
- **man -k *keyword*** Display manual help file related to the *keyword*
- **passwd** Change your login password
- **pwd** Display the path name of where you are
- **uptime** Tell you how long the machine has been up and running
- **users** Tell you who is logging in
- **who** Tell you who is logging-in in detail
- **w** Tell you who is logging in and doing what!
- **whoami** Show you the owner of this account
- **finger *user*** Find out the personal information of a user
- **finger *name*** Try to find the person’s info. by his/her name
- **finger *email-address*** Try to find the person’s info across the network
- **write *user*** Write a message on somebody’s screen
- **talk *user*** Talk to the person logging in the same system with you
- **talk *email-address*** Talk to somebody logging in the network
- **date** Display today’s time and date
- **cal *year*** Display the calendar of the specified year (e.g. 1997)
