Overview of Mobile Apps Dev

Plan → Design → Develop → Test → Distribute

- Design
 - What will users **see**?
 - Multi-languages?
 - What things are **behind the scene**?
 - Program logic
 - How will users use your app?
 - Any expected flow? Event driven?
 - User friendliness is very important!

- Develop
 - **Front end**
 - **Back end**
- Test & Debug
 - Real devices
 - Emulators

Challenges in real world

- Lots of devices with variations in
 - **Screen size** and **ratios**
 - **Processing Power**
 - **OS version**
 - **Manufacturers** (Customizations)
 - ...

Some terms (for Beginners in programming)

- UI
 - User Interfaces
- SDK (Software Development Kit)
 - Set of dev tools that allows the creation of apps in a software framework/ platform
- Eclipse
 - Integrated Development Environment (IDE)
 - Software for developing apps

Android dev terms

- ADT
 - Android Development Tools (Plugin for Eclipse)
- AVD
 - Android Virtual Device
- DDMS
 - Dalvik Debug Monitor Server
- Manifest
- Activity
- Service
- Fragment
