Your submission will include:

A personal statement

- 1) Max length: 500 words
- 2) Language: English
- 3) You may refer to the guiding questions below:
 - Why would you like to pursue this transdisciplinary degree?
 - What relevant experience and/or achievements relating to entrepreneurship and teamwork have you had (e.g. competitions, student activities, use of digital technologies and social media and/or volunteering work)?

A short video

- 1) Max length: 2 minutes
- 2) Language: English
- 3) You may refer to the guiding questions below:
 - Why are you interested in the entertainment business, arts, culture, and/or creative industries?
 - What are your career aspirations?
 - How and why are you suited to studying this programme?

Creative works (Optional)

Applicants may also submit any works which can demonstrate creativity. The works can be of any kind, such as drawing, painting, filming, video, photography, performance, musical composition, digital arts and design (apps and website design, VR, AR, and gaming developments), and STEAM projects.

Submission Guidelines

- 1) All portfolios should be prepared in English (except creative works).
- 2) All portfolios should contain the following student identification data on the first page of the portfolio:
 - Applicant Name
 - Application No.
 - Telephone Contact
 - Email Contact
- 3) For creative works, please indicate whether they were individual or group work.
- 4) The file should be named using your Non-JUPAS Application Number (e.g. if your application number is N50123456, your file should be named N50123456.pdf / N50123456.docx / N50123456.pptx).

How to Submit?

An official email notification regarding the submission details and submission link will be sent to your registered email in due course upon application.

(Save your portfolio as a PDF / Microsoft Word / PowerPoint file, and include a YouTube link of the video (set as “unlisted”). Please keep the total file size of all your PDFs and/or images under 20MB.)

- Portfolios that cannot be opened due to inherited problem of the uploaded files
- Portfolios in hard copies
